MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

My dear Parishioners,

Tomorrow is Memorial Day and I thought I would dedicate my letter to this national holiday.

Originally, Memorial Day was called Decoration Day and it was borne out of the Civil War and a desire to remember its dead. It was officially proclaimed on 5 May 1868 by General John Lozano. He wrote, "The 30th of May, 1868, is designated for the purpose of strewing with flowers, or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village and hamlet churchyard in the Land." The day of Decoration Day was chosen because there was no battle recorded on that specific date.

By 1890, this commemoration was adopted by all the Northern States but the South refused to acknowledge that day, choosing to honor their dead on a separate day until after World War 1, when the holiday changed from honoring just the Civil War dead to honoring all Americans who died fighting in any war.

It is now observed in almost every state on the last Monday in May. This helped ensure a three day weekend for Federal holidays, although several Southern States have an additional holiday honoring the Confederate dead. In Louisiana, it is 3 June, the birthday of Jefferson Davis.

Interestingly to note there is a tradition of wearing a red poppy on Memorial Day to honor those who died serving the nation. That custom was inspired by a poem, written by Moira Michael wherein she wrote,

"We cherish too, the Poppy red
That grows on fields where valor led.
It seems to signal to the skies
That blood of heroes never dies."

So, on this Memorial Day weekend, let us thank God for these heroes and heroines who have given their lives to secure our freedom and our peace.
