My Dear Parishioners,

It is official, June is here. And every June I think of my mother's mint green suit that she made for my sister's wedding way back in 1970. She was a fastidious seamstress with the inside of the suit as finished as the outside. Perhaps that's where I get my attention to detail. If she said this once, she said it 1000 times, "If it is worth doing, it is worth doing well." Unfortunately, many don't ascribe to that practice. Many look at the big picture only and if the task accomplishes the deed, how it accomplishes the deed is not so important. My mother saw both – the big picture and the detail and I know her life would have been less stressful if she had let go of many small details and simply accomplished the minimum. But, she didn't and it taught us, her children, to make sure we do things right – that the inside which people don't see is as finished as the outside which people do see. There is a certain truthfulness about one's work when it is attended to in this fashion; a certain integrity. That is how God creates. He is attentive to the internal as well as the external; He is concerned that the beauty He creates is not just skin deep or surface level. His created beauty is from surface to core. As a result, when we approach a task with that in mind, we have the potential to be co-creators with God the Father.

CENTENNIAL NEWS

• **Bishop Boudreaux** - On June 4, 1971, Bishop Warren Boudreaux was appointed to serve as the second bishop of the Diocese of Beaumont, Texas. Boudreaux, a native of Berwick, was ordained a priest by Bishop Jeanmard in 1942. He served in many capacities for the diocese, including as vice-chancellor, secretary to the bishop, and vicar general. While remaining pastor of St. Peter in New Iberia, Boudreaux served as Auxiliary Bishop of Lafayette from 1962-1971 when he was appointed to Beaumont. After six years of service in Beaumont, Bishop Boudreaux was installed on June 5, 1977 as the first Bishop of the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux.
