JANUARY MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING CONTINUED

The Men's Mass for January was held on Thursday, January 24 and celebrated by Msgr. Louis Melancon with 38 men in attendance. Due to weather and scheduling problems, no Men's Mass was held in the month of February. However, an "envelope stuffing party" was held on Thursday, February 8 in which 30 people gathered to help prepare a mailing of the Little Black Lenten Devotionals. Over 1,600 envelopes were stuffed with a devotional and a letter from Msgr. DeRouen and sent to all parish families, as has been done over the past several years.

The annual Married Couples Mass celebrated by Msgr. DeRouen was held on Wednesday, March 14 in Queen of Angels Church Hall with 30 couples in attendance. Monsignor DeRouen delivered a very nice homily which encouraged all in the Sacrament of Marriage and Mark LeBlanc once again blessed us with a delicious gumbo meal while several ladies prepared homemade cookies, brownies, etc.

The Men's Mass for April was held on Wednesday, April 25 at Stevie Dupuis' lake house. We had about 70 men in attendance with Msgr. Louis Melancon celebrating Mass. Following Mass, retreat captains Stevie Dupuis and Joey Diesi spoke of the silent retreat to be held in August at Our Lady of the Oaks Retreat House in Grand Coteau. All in attendance were encouraged to attend the August retreat. Guitarist Richard Tatman accompanied all with wonderful worship music which really added to the celebration of the Eucharist. A delicious meal of jambalaya, fried catfish, fried shrimp and chicken salad sandwiches, was provided by Stevie Dupuis and Don Fisher.

Information is still being gathered on connecting with the Ragin Cajun Catholic program at UL-Lafayette in regards to developing a program for high school seniors. Discussions are also being held on addressing the issue of pornography.

CENTENNIAL NEWS

- **Pope Chooses Lafayette's First Bishop** - On July 18, 1918 the Archdiocese of New Orleans received an important letter from Pope Benedict XV. The Holy Father signed the order appointing Jules B. Jeanmard as the first Bishop of the Diocese of Lafayette on July 4, 1918. The Pope had created the Diocese almost 6 months earlier on January 11th, but no Bishop had been named. Many suspected that Fr. Teurlings may have been named bishop, but the 38 year old native of Breaux Bridge was chosen. Jeanmard was shocked to receive the news, and wrote to a friend proclaiming: "I am still hoping against hope that it may not be true... Poor Lafayette is getting a sorry specimen for its first shepherd."
- **National Association of Catholic Family Life Ministries** – in this Centennial Year, the Diocese of Lafayette is happy to host a national Marriage and Family Conference – July 15-17 at the Cajundome Convention Center. Please pray for the holiness of marriage and family and the success of this conference happening this week.
- **Fête-Dieu du Vermilion**, Eucharistic Boat Procession up the Vermilion River, will take place on the Feast of the Assumption, **Wednesday, August 15**. All are invited to a Mass in French at 8am at St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church in Abbeville to begin the day. Bishop Glen Provost of the Lake Charles Diocese will preside and give the homily. At the end of Mass there will be a procession from Church with the Blessed Sacrament and a statue of Mary across the draw bridge to Riverfront Restaurant (503 W. Port St.). At 10:00 am 121 boats will embark in procession (one for each parish of the Diocese) and make their way up Bayou Vermilion to Lafayette. The boat procession will stop in Milton at Wawee's at 11:35 am for recitation of the rosary and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The flotilla will re-commence at 12:35 pm and continue upstream, arriving at Ruffino's in River Ranch at 1:40 pm for Rosary and Benediction. The boat procession will embark once again at 2:40 pm and arrive at Beaver Park at about 3:20 pm. Persons interested in making the "100-Year Walk" to the Cathedral can gather at Vermilionville at 3PM and use the bike path under the Thruway to muster at the boat landing. At 3:45 pm a foot procession with the Blessed Sacrament and a statue of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary will leave the landing and process up University Avenue in Lafayette all the way to the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist. Solemn Vespers will be prayed at 5:00 pm and Holy Mass will follow at 5:30 pm with Bishop Douglas Deshotel to conclude the historic day. Buses will be available to shuttle walkers back to Vermilionville as needed. Confessions will be heard in mobile units at each of the stops along the way.
