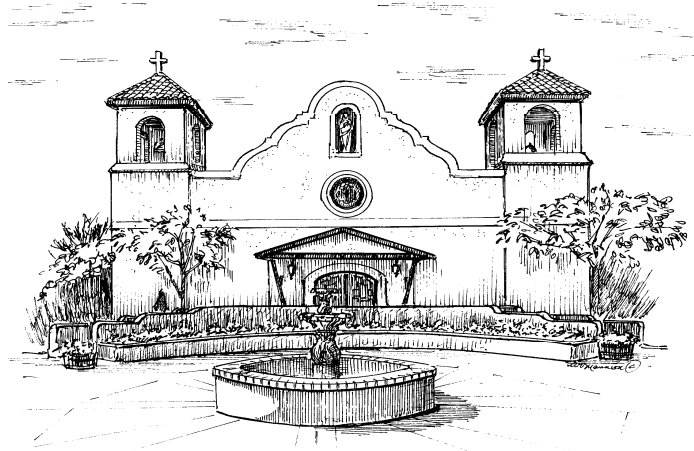

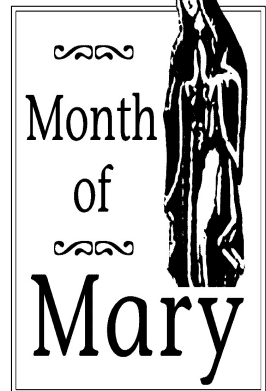

NOVENA TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS:

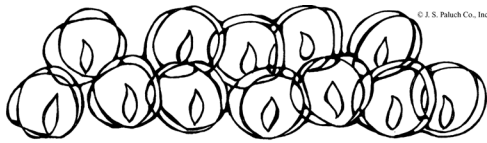
