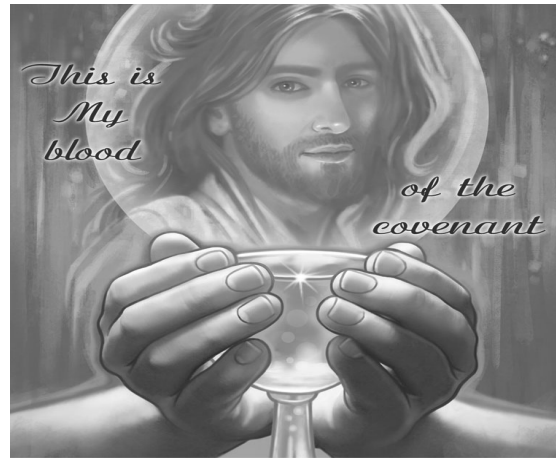
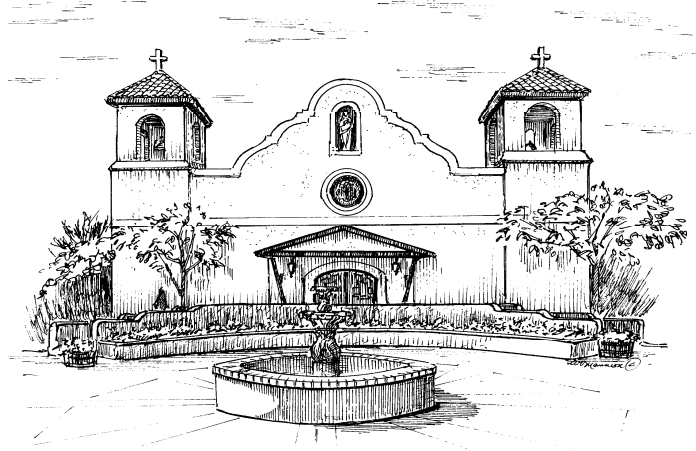

USHERS - MANDATORY meeting with **ALL** Ushers in mid-June. Details to be announced soon!!

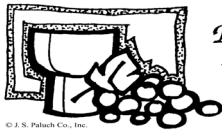
