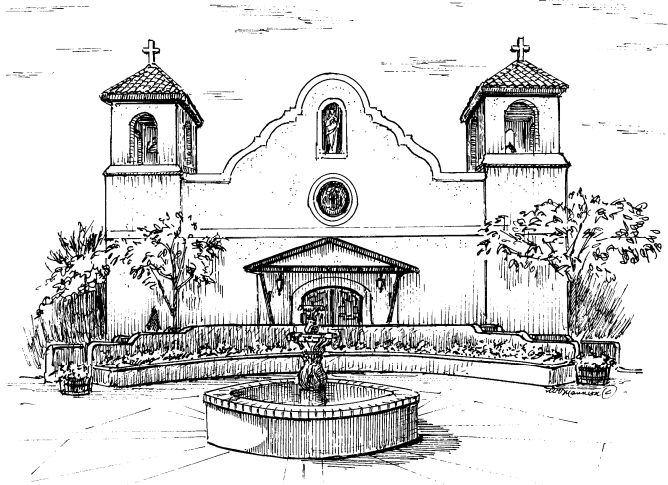

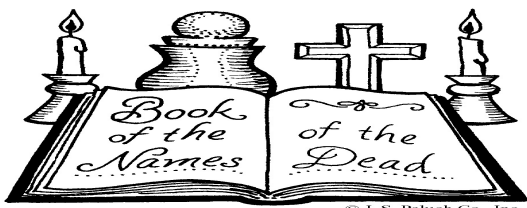
THURSDAY EVENING CONFESSION HAS CHANGED TO ALLOW MORE WORKERS THE SACRAMENT
