

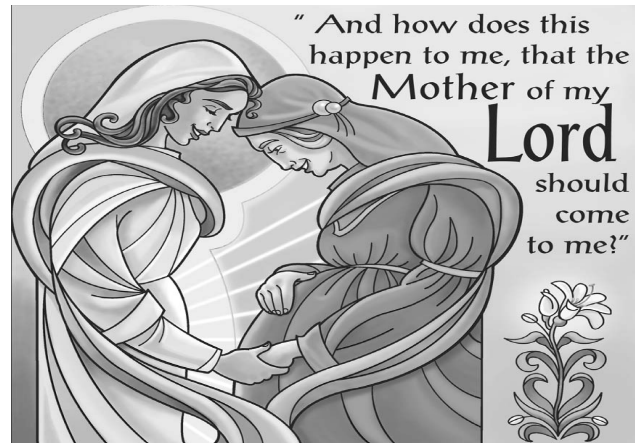
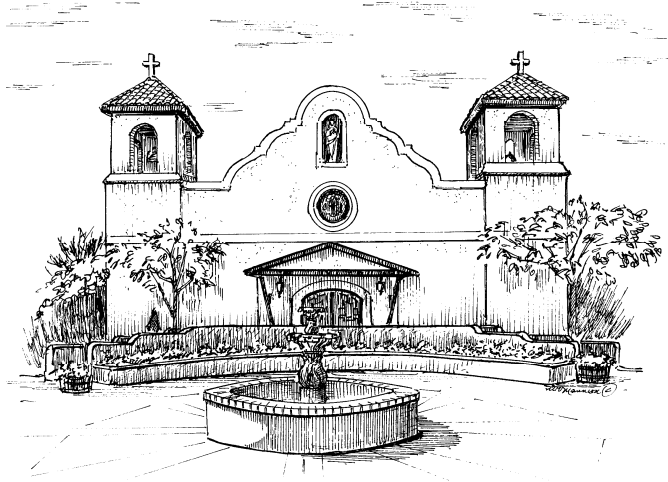

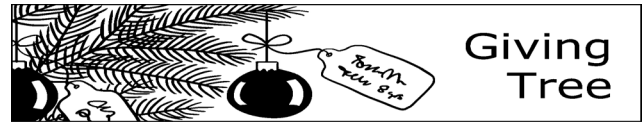

Some of the Graces & Fruits Received in Attending Holy Mass:

“For your salvation: ...God the Father sends His beloved Son down from Heaven, [and] the Holy Spirit changes bread and wine into the true Body and Blood of Christ. ...For your sake, the Son of God comes down from Heaven and conceals Himself under the form of the sacred Host. For your salvation: ...He renews the saving mystery of the Incarnation, [and] He is born anew into the world in a mystic manner whenever the Holy Mass is celebrated. ...He pardons you all your *venial* sins [not mortal, in the reception of the Eucharist] provided you are FIRMLY resolved to forsake them [and that you allow His will to be done before your own whenever serving both Him and all persons around you.] ...NEVER can you pray so well as while [totally in mind, heart, body, and soul you are] present [and actively participating] in the Mass. ...This is so because Christ unites His prayers to yours and offers them to His heavenly Father.”

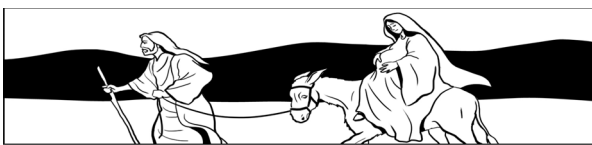
