Regarding Mass Intentions.....

Many good people here have brought to my attention their concern for the limit of Mass intentions that is now in force in 2016, here at Sacred Heart. Simply put, the earlier practice of accepting *more than* three Mass intentions was not following Church Law.

✚ **Per the Church's Law, know as Canon Law, in its 3rd Chapter of "The Sanctifying Function of the Church, Book IV" it tells us that:**

☞ In Canon (or Law) # 945: Only ONE intention per Mass can be offered. It says, "an offering" *not multiple offerings* can be "appl[ied] to the Mass for a specific intention."

☞ In Canon (or Law) # 957: We understand that the bishop can override this –if necessary– with the law's words "the duty and right of exercising vigilance that Mass obligations are fulfilled belong to the local ordinary." Our Archbishop = our Ordinary. *Thankfully, our archbishops (a.k.a. our ordinaries) have consistently TRIPLED the amount of intentions we may have for each Mass because we have a shortage of priests and the Mass intentions for a year could not be fulfilled otherwise.*

!\\ We must not abuse this privilege; we should be thankful that we can have up to 3 intentions per Mass.

☞ In Canon (or Law) # 953: It clearly states, "No one [priest] is permitted to accept more offerings for Masses to be applied by himself than he can satisfy within a year." In response to this, I have adopted a more conservative approach by asking my secretary to accept intentions for *up to* 26 of the year's weekends in advance, per family. I want to give all people a fair opportunity to have intentions and not permit only a few people to "book" all of the weekend intentions for the year. Besides, the weekday intentions are just as important as the weekend intentions. ...That is because the value of each Mass is the price of Christ's body and blood for us!
