† Feast Day of the Week †

November 1st – Solemnity of All Saints

While many Saints have a specific feast day on which we celebrate their lives and work, most of the Saints of Heaven do not. The *Solemnity of All Saints* is a reminder that salvation is open to all of us. It is also a celebration of the holy people, known and unknown, formally canonized and not, who are with God in Heaven. The earliest certain observance of a feast in honor of all the Saints is an early 4th century commemoration of "all the martyrs". Several centuries later, after successive waves of invaders plundered the catacombs, Pope Boniface IV gathered up some 28 wagonloads of bones and reinterred them beneath the Pantheon, a Roman temple dedicated to all the gods. The pope rededicated the shrine as a Christian church, where the memories of the Saints could be honored. Over the centuries, as Christians became more free to worship according to their conscience, the Church recognized other paths to sanctity beyond martyrdom alone. The *Solemnity of All Saints* honors the unknown as well as the famous – the saints each of us have known.

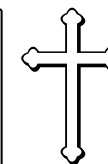
