### WORSHIP

#### GODS PROVIDENCE

Today's readings celebrate God's providence. No matter how wonderful (or heartbreaking) our relationships are, God always provides for us. No one cares for us the way God does. Isaiah delights us with a deeply intimate image of God caring for us as a mother comforts her child. The prophet describes us not as the usual children of God, but as babies. We should not resist this image, but rejoice in it. Trusting in God's care, we can all let down our guard and rest like infants in the lap of our mother.

Saint Paul's trust in God allows him to be at peace like this. He boldly declares that no one can make troubles for him, because he has given himself completely to Jesus. And when Jesus sends his disciples out to preach and heal, he challenges them not to provide for themselves, but to let faith be their guide.

## CAMPAIGN FOR OUR NEW CHURCH



As of **June 1**, here's where we stand regarding our campaign goals to be met to break ground in November:

**Capital campaign gifts:** Our goal is **\$3,100,000** and we have received gifts of **\$2,877,329** to-date toward pledges of 3,398,955. **\$34,187** in gifts was received during May.

**Parish savings account:** Our goal is **\$1,900,000** and we currently have **\$1,932,648** in the bank

**Fundraisers:** Our goal is **\$150,000** and we have raised **\$198,842** to-date through the various fundraisers.

This all adds up to a **total of \$5,008,819** on hand now toward our overall goal of **\$5,150,000** leaving us just **\$141,181** to go by mid-2019.

## Upcoming St. Vincent de Paul Collections

On **July 13-14**, there will be a second collection for the annual **Archdiocesan Black-Bag for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul**. This collection will go to the Archdiocese to support the St. Vincent de Paul efforts across the Archdiocese. Thanks to your past financial support, in 2018, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in the Galveston-Houston area were able to provide much needed assistance with food, rent, utilities, medical, clothing, utility bills, and many other needs.

The second **collection to support St. Vincent de Paul at St. Matthias will be the following weekend, July 20-21**. This monthly collection is the primary source of income for our St. Vincent de Paul ministry. 96% of the support they receive is returned to those in need with only 4% going toward operating costs for the ministry. For the period Oct 2017 thru Sept 2018, our St. Vincent de Paul ministry helped approximately 10,000 people with food and helped 1,775 people with services (utilities, rent, medical, ...).
