CHECKLIST FOR BAPTISM OF INFANTS

For Parents:

_____ Attend a Baptism Preparation Class, either at St. Peter's or another parish (if you have taken a baptism class within the past three years, **you do not need to take another class**).

_____ Complete Infant Baptism Request Form and turn in to the Parish Office, **along with the following**:

- Copy of your child's State-registered Birth Certificate
- Certificates of attendance at a Baptism Preparation class within the past three years, for parents and Godparents
- **If you are not a parishioner of St. Peter's** - A letter from your parish pastor granting permission for your child to be baptized at St. Peter's.
- Letters of Verification of Full Communion with the Church from the parish of each Godparent
- Completed and signed Godparent Certificates

For Godparents*:

_____ Inform Godparents of their requirements to attend a Baptism Preparation Class (again, if they have taken one of these classes within the past three years, this will not be necessary).

_____ Have each Godparent fill out and sign a Godparent Certificate.

_____ Ask each Godparent to request a Letter of Verification of Full Communion with the Church from their parish. The letter must be signed by the pastor and stamped with the parish seal.

***For a person to stand as a Godparent or Sponsor, the following requirements must be met:**

- Be designated by the candidate, parents, guardians, or pastor
- Have the intention of performing the role of sponsor
- Be at least 16 years old
- Be a fully initiated Catholic (received Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation)
- Lead a life in harmony with the Faith and role of a sponsor (i.e. be a registered member of a parish, attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days and faithful to the laws of the Church regarding marriage)
- Not bound by any canonical penalty
- Not the father or mother of the candidate

At least one of the persons you choose must fulfil these requirements. If you wish to honor a non-Catholic member of your family, they may stand as a Christian Witness to your child's Baptism, provided they have already been baptized.
