Dear Parishioners,

A couple of years ago, Bishop Dorsonville (one of the auxiliary bishops of Washington), asked me to be part of a 3-year program with other priests where I would travel to a country in Central America to study a little Spanish and to learn the various customs and traditions of the land. Last year around this time, I travelled to Nicaragua and spent just under 3 weeks there.

Beginning on Monday, August 6, I will be travelling to El Salvador and expect to return in time for the weekend Masses of August 25-26. This is very difficult for me to be away for so long since I have just been settling in and will now have to re-settle in when I get back.

Some might be wondering what the point is in this program. In recent years, the diocese has placed a greater emphasis on its priests being more familiar with the Spanish language and the cultures of many of the immigrants that have come to the DC area. Most seminarians in our diocese study some Spanish in the seminary and spend an entire summer in a Spanish speaking country. I did neither of these while I was in the seminary, which is probably why this program will be beneficial for me. While the Spanish language probably isn't all that useful here in the 7th District, it will come in handy when a parish in southern Maryland that does have Spanish Masses has its Spanish speaking priest go out of town for some time away. It is not easy finding coverage for Masses, especially when they are in another language.

I am grateful for the generosity of a few retired priests who will cover the Masses for me while I am away. Fr. Francis Early will be covering most of the Masses at Sacred Heart. Fr. George Wilkinson will be covering most of the Masses at Holy Angels. Fr. James Meyers will be covering a few of the daily Masses at Sacred Heart and Holy Angels.

Please pray for me while I am away and be assured of my prayers for you. I am so grateful to all of you for the kindness and support you have shown me in my first few weeks as your administrator. You are so patient with this priest who has a lot of names to remember and a lot of keys on my keychain that I still need to figure out what they unlock.
