BACK TO SCHOOL – BACKPACK PROGRAM

Our St. Vincent de Paul conference is pleased to announce this year's **BACK TO SCHOOL – BACKPACK PROGRAM** for the children of our parish. In the vestibule, there is a poster with tags attached for two separate gifts; one for a new backpack, and another for school supplies. Each backpack tag identifies the gender and class grade of the student, and possibly a special request for a particular model. Each supplies tag lists the required materials appropriate for the **student's** grade level and corresponds to a student's backpack. We invite our parishioners to select a tag, and purchase either a backpack, or the corresponding supplies, for a student. Please do not include any supplies with backpacks. After selecting a tag, please print your name on the form near the poster and list the tag number next to your name. This is a necessary control to ensure all gifts are distributed properly. Return the backpack or the supplies with the tag attached to the Church office during office hours or to the Church by **July 7th**. The backpacks with supplies will be distributed to the children on **July 20th**. We encourage you to participate in this important program for our students and thank you again for your loving generosity.
