The remaining project component is our electric powered lift which will begin fabrication after the concrete pours are done and the final dimensions are confirmed. ST VINCENT DE PAUL

St. Vincent de Paul is pleased to announce they will be having the second annual FRIENDS OF THE POOR WALK on Saturday, September 28th. The walk will be different this year; from our parish all the way down to the park by the Rio Vista Bridge and back again, roughly 1 ½ miles. There will be more information about the walk next month. They hope to build on last year’s very successful walk to bring the plight of the poor of our community to the attention of all.

LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The liturgical calendar contains two cycles. The first is called the *Temporal Cycle* and includes all Sundays and feasts of our Lord. Every Sunday is a renewed celebration of Christ’s Resurrection from the dead; indeed, the Lord’s Day is “a little Easter”. The second cycle in the liturgical calendar is called the *Sanctoral Cycle* and includes the feast days of the Virgin Mary, the martyrs, and the saints. There are three distinct levels for ranking the feast days in the Church. A *solemnity* is the liturgical celebration of the highest rank that commemorates an event, a person, or a belief of the great importance. Lower than a *solemnity* is a *feast*, lower still is a *memorial*. Examples of these celebrations will be given next week.

EL AÑO LITÚRGICO

El calendario litúrgico contiene dos ciclos. El primero se llama *Ciclo Temporal* e incluye todos los domingos y fiestas de nuestro Señor. Cada domingo es una celebración renovada de la Resurrección de Cristo; de hecho, el día del Señor es “una Pascua pequeña”. El segundo ciclo en el calendario litúrgico se llama *Ciclo Santoral* e incluye los días festivos de la Virgen María, los mártires y los santos. Hay tres niveles distintos para clasificar los días festivos en la Iglesia. La *solemnidad* es la celebración litúrgica del más alto rango que conmemora un evento, una persona o una creencia de gran importancia. Abajo de la *solemnidad* es un *día festivo*, aún más bajo es una *conmemoración*. Se darán ejemplos de estas celebraciones la próxima semana.
