1. Log in to SchoolSpeak. Call the school office if you need your username and password.
2. Click on your log-in name in the upper right-hand corner.
3. Update your parent profile with current contact information.
4. Click on "Update Family" in the upper right-hand corner to update profiles of your spouse and all children. The student profiles include very important emergency contact and medical information along with some of the permission forms that were previously included in your back-to-school packets!
