Hello to you all! I am Father Prince Amala Jesuraja, (people call me Father Prince) a Catholic priest belonging to the Archdiocese of Madurai, Tamil Nadu, India. I was ordained as a priest on April 19, 2009.

Let me give you brief explanation about my name: 'Amala' means "Immaculate Mary" in my Tamil Language (my mother's tongue) and 'Jesuraja' means "Christ the King."

In my past six years of priestly life in India, I have served as an Associate Pastor in different parishes for three years and, for two and half years, I was appointed as an Assistant Director in my diocesan social service society by my Archbishop, the Most. Rev. Antony Papusamy. Before coming to the United States, I was functioning as a Rector in our diocesan minor seminary of St. Pius X.

After coming to Wisconsin and the Diocese of La Crosse in May 2015, I was at Stevens Point for one month and then, for the past four months, I've been receiving enculturation with Fr. Don Meuret, the pastor of Immaculate Conception parish in Eau Claire. Now I am glad and grateful to the La Crosse Diocese Bishop, the Most Rev. William Patrick Callahan, who appointed me as a parochial administrator for Elmwood, Spring Valley and Boyceville.

Regarding my family, my dad, Jebamalai Selvaraj, and my mum, Nirmala, are living in my home town, Rajapalayam, (400 Miles away from Chennai South India). I am the eldest in my family and have one younger brother, Franklin, who is working as a teacher in a public school. He is married to Philomina and they have a two year old son, Pio Melvin.
