Our Lord Jesus Christ King of the Universe

Today is the Feast of Christ the King. What image comes to your mind when someone mentions the word ‘King’? For me, I think of crowns and rich robes, attendants and royal surroundings, soldiers and subjects. He has a staff in his hand. Many servants and other people are there to minister to him. I think of worldly power, a strong fighting force and a man who must constantly be watchful of others in his kingdom who might hope to replace him. If that is the common perception of a “king” then Jesus Christ hardly qualifies because all of these could not be found with this King we are talking about today.

Pope Pius XI instituted the Solemnity of Christ the King on December 11, 1925 in his encyclical ‘Quas Primas’. At that time he saw the rise of atheistic communism and secularism as a direct result of man’s turning away from Christ’s sovereignty, and man’s denying of the authority of Christ’s Church. This result was “disorder” or a move away from the Divine Order. The Feast of Christ the King was set on the last Sunday in October. After the Second Vatican Council, the calendar reforms of 1969 moved the date of the Feast of Christ the King to the last Sunday before the next liturgical year’s Advent (Advent marking the start of the liturgical year and beginning four Sundays before Christmas Day).

This feast is an invitation to all those who have power or authority of any kind to compare their use of power or authority with Jesus. Are they using their power to serve others or to manipulate? Are they using their power for the building up of a more just society or to feather their own nest? Are they using their power in any way that might cause pain on others or in a way that could help to alleviate pain?

Let us pray to God so that the faithfulness and truthfulness which Jesus exemplifies in His life, maybe ours too.
