

Saturday morning (March 14), a Morning Retreat for First Holy Communion was held for our young people preparing to receive. The morning involved activities, videos, church scavenger hunt, and bread making to foster children's connection in faith between the bread and wine that become the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It was a great morning of smiles, learning, and faith. Thank you to Terri Nigh and the other catechists for providing such a wonderful

Last year when we used the school gym for our temporary church, you may have had the "opportunity" to use one of the four restrooms in the school building. If so, then you no doubt realized they need serious attention. I've been told nothing has been done to them in decades! It shows. Hence, the Finance Council and Parish Council have approved renovations of those four bathrooms. We have signed a Letter of Agreement with Entheos Architects to provide design for the renovations. While the work has not yet been bid or scheduled, Entheos is optimistic that we might be able to complete all four restrooms over the 2015 school summer break. At the very least, we will complete two this summer and two next. The estimated cost per bathroom for the needed overhaul including accessibility (ADA) upgrades is \$50,000 to \$60,000 each. Parish savings will be utilized for this work. There will be no capital campaign. However, if you would like to support financially this work, donations would be appreciated (please note "School Bathrooms" on the donation). As the design work progresses, I will keep you informed. This is a needed venture as we continue to care for and maintain all our parish facilities.


