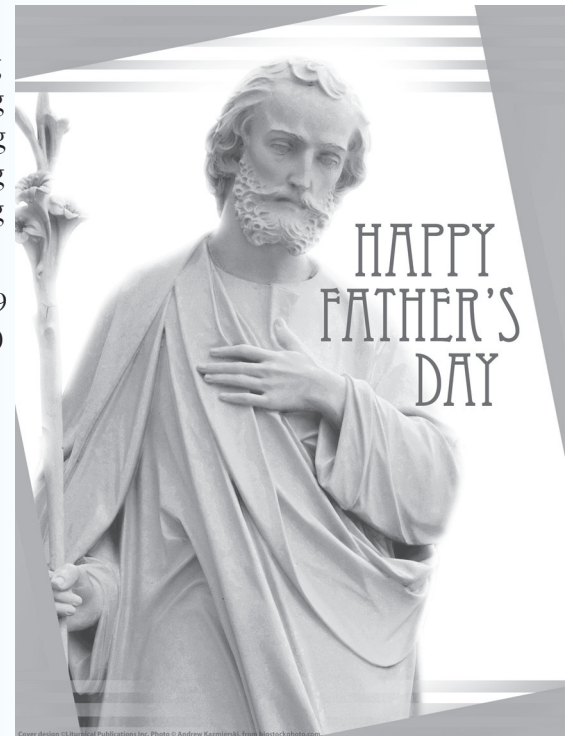

Marriage Engaged couples must meet with the Pastor to complete initial marriage paperwork at least 9 months before the anticipated wedding date *and prior to making any other arrangements concerning the wedding.*



Joseph did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took Mary into his home to be his wife (Mt 1:24). “It was to assure fatherly protection for Jesus that God chose Joseph to be Mary's spouse. It follows that Joseph's fatherhood - a relationship that places him as close as possible to Christ, to whom every election and predestination is ordered (cf. Rom 8:28-29) - comes to pass through marriage to Mary, that is, through the family... St. Joseph was called by God to serve the person and mission of Jesus directly through the exercise of his fatherhood. It is precisely in this way that... he ‘cooperated in the fullness of time in the great mystery of salvation’ and is truly a ‘minister of salvation.’ His fatherhood is expressed concretely ‘in his having made his life a service, a sacrifice to the mystery of the Incarnation and to the redemptive mission connected with it; in having used the legal authority which was his over the Holy Family in order to make a total gift of self, of his life and work; in having turned his human vocation to domestic love into a superhuman oblation of self... at the service of the Messiah growing up in his house.’ ‘God placed him at the head of his family, as a faithful and prudent servant, so that with fatherly care he might watch over His only begotten Son’... Since it is inconceivable that such a sublime task would not be matched by the necessary qualities to adequately fulfill it, we must recognize that Joseph showed Jesus ‘by a special gift from heaven, all the natural love, all the affectionate solicitude that a father's heart can know.’” (St Pope John Paul II, *Redemptoris Custos* (15 August 1989), 7-8)

Happy Father's Day to all fathers. While you've not been chosen to be the adoptive father of the Messiah, your fatherhood of the children entrusted to you is no less important. You should take St Joseph as your model. Yours too should be a life of service, a sacrifice, a total gift of self, dedicated to domestic love. May you too be ‘righteous men’ leading your families, your children, to one true Father.
