RCIA Sessions (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) are beginning this Sunday, August 6 at 8:30am in the rectory conference room. If interested in becoming a Catholic Christian or simply learning more about the Catholic Faith, please join us. All are welcome. There is no obligation at this point other than an openness to learn and grow in Christ and the Church. If, down the road, you discern you are called to enter into Full Communion, wonderful. If you discern not yet, then thank God you were open to learning and growing. If you know a friend, family member, or neighbor who might be interested, please invite them (come along yourself to give them support!).

Registration for ***That Man Is You*** (TMIY) for new participants will take place this weekend and next. Men enrolled last year need not re-register, as I understand it. I would invite all men of the parish 18 and up to seriously pray about whether God may be calling you to join this group. I have seen tremendous growth in the men of the parish in their relationship to Christ and the Church by their participation. It could be just what you need.

Registration for our **Religious Education** (RE) programs Kindergarten through 12th grade will be held after all the Masses next weekend. We will continue the *Family Formation* program that we initiated last year for K-6. The *Family Formation* arrangement has parents and me meeting the first weekend of the month, while their children attend a catechesis class. They then have materials to work on together as a family over the rest of the week. We will again utilize *Formed.org* as the backbone for the 7-12th grade formation content. I recently reviewed feedback forms from last spring, and it was nearly unanimously positive. I was encouraged by statements like: "I am much more involved in my children's spiritual education. Faith is a more frequent topic of conversation in our home." "Our child mentions Jesus and God to his friends and family." "This has encouraged our family to talk more about the Catholic faith." These were precisely my intention with the adoption of the in-home family based catechesis model. It is my hope that our homes, lives, and relationships may be sanctified; that what we say and do in Mass each weekend may be echoed and reinforced by what we say and do in our family homes each day.

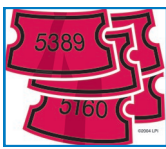
