New Adult Faith Opportunity



The Turning Point: A Study of the Gospel of John. This isn't your typical Bible study. It's a nine-session Bible Study experience that will introduce you to eight miraculous encounters with

Jesus in the Gospel of John that will help you encounter Jesus in a new and personal way. It's perfect for people who want to get to know Jesus in the Scriptures.

This study will introduce you to people and stories in the Gospel of John that you won't find anywhere else in the Bible: the woman at the well; a man named Nicodemus; the woman caught in adultery; and Lazarus. You'll read stories about Jesus turning water into wine at the wedding in Cana, Jesus washing the feet of his disciples, and Peter's marvelous redemption after he denies Jesus three times.

The first session will meet Wednesday, August 15, directly after the 6:30p.m. Feast of the Assumption Mass (approximately 7:40p.m.) in the multi-purpose room. This first session should only last one hour. Each participant will receive a packet that consists of: one workbook, DVD's and RSV Gospel According to John. The cost of the packet is only \$16.00.
