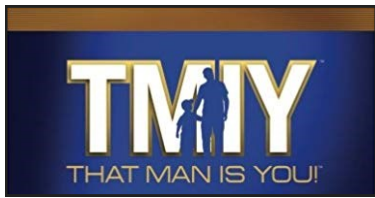
We ask this through Christ our Brother, in the power of the Holy Spirit.
