3. **Discuss** the material with your parent(s)

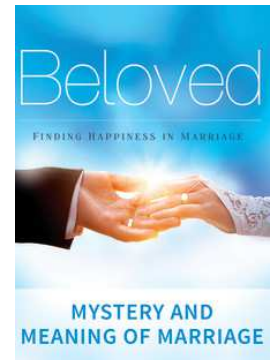
