From Pastor's desk: The Nativity of St. John the Baptist. *Reflection: Luke 1, 57 – 66, 80: John is his name.*

Today, we solemnly celebrate the Nativity of the Baptist. St. John is a man of contrasts: he lives in the silence of the desert, but right from there he appeals to the crowds with convincing voice inviting them to convert; he is humble enough to say he is only the voice, not the Word, but he does not mince his words and dares to accuse and denounce all injustices even to the very king; he urges his disciples to meet with Jesus, but he does not mind rebuking king Herod while he is in prison. Silent and humble, he is also strong and courageous enough to shed his blood. John the Baptist is a great man! The greatest of them all, as Jesus himself will say in praise, but he is only Christ's precursor. Through the baptism, we have been all chosen and sent to bear witness of the Lord. In an environment of indifference, St. John is a helping example to imitate. In John, his attitude as a Messenger, clearly explicit in attentive prayer to the Spirit, in his fortitude and humility, helps us to establish new horizons of sanctity for us and for our brother. The Lord asks you to proclaim to others the great gift you have received. Before Jesus was born, John the Baptist was chosen by God to prepare the world for the Son of God. Today, as we remember the birth of Saint John the Baptist, let us recall our own baptism and our initiation into the Christian faith.

Gracious and loving God, you sent John the Baptist to point the way to the Messiah. Through the inspiration of John the Baptist, help us reflect your Son, as moon reflects the sun.

Desde el escritorio del Pastor: La Natividad de San Juan el Bautista. *Reflexión: Lucas 1, 57 - 66, 80: Juan es su nombre.*

Hoy celebramos solemnemente la Natividad del Bautista. San Juan es un hombre de contrastes: vive en el silencio del desierto, pero desde allí atrae a la multitud con voz convincente invitándolos a convertirse; él es lo suficientemente humilde como para decir que él es solo la voz, no la Palabra, pero que no se apura en sus palabras y se atreve acusar y denunciar todas las injusticias incluso al mismo rey; él le pide a sus discípulos que se reúnan con Jesús, pero no le importa reprochar al rey Herodes mientras está en la cárcel. Silencioso y humilde, también es lo suficientemente fuerte y valiente como para derramar su sangre. ¡Juan el Bautista es un gran hombre! el más grande de todos, como Jesús mismo dirá en alabanza, pero él es solo el precursor de Cristo A través del bautismo, todos hemos sido elegidos y enviados para dar testimonio del Señor. En un ambiente de indiferencia, San Juan es un ejemplo de ayuda para imitar. En Juan, su actitud como Mensajero, claramente explícita en la oración atenta al Espíritu, en su fortaleza y humildad, nos ayuda a establecer nuevos horizontes de santidad para nosotros y para nuestro hermano. El Señor te pide que proclames a los demás el gran regalo que has recibido. Antes de que naciera Jesús, Juan el Bautista fue elegido por Dios para preparar el mundo para el Hijo de Dios. Hoy, cuando recordamos el nacimiento de San Juan Bautista, recordemos nuestro propio bautismo y nuestra iniciación en la fe cristiana.

Dios bondadoso y amoroso, enviaste a Juan el Bautista para señalar el camino hacia el Mesías. A través de la inspiración de Juan el Bautista, ayúdanos a reflejar a tu Hijo, ya que la luna refleja el sol.
