From Pastor's desk: Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018. *Reflection: Mark 5, 21 – 43: Little girl, I say to you, arise!* The story of Jairus' daughter is one of many miracle stories about Jesus healing a seriously ill child at the bequest of the child's parent or guardian. It follows beautifully upon account of the healing of the servant of centurion. In some of these stories of healing, Jesus tells the adult to go home because their faith has already brought about the healing. But in the case of Jairus, Jesus drops everything and companies him to the home. Jesus says to the child, Talitha koum (Little girl, stand up). The healing could have been done at a distance, but touch makes a difference. Like so much in life, personal contact in itself brings about much healing. Jesus and his disciples continually on the move. They are on a mission, and it is important that they travel to spread the Good News. It is also important, as we see today, that people of faith have an opportunity to encounter Jesus. It's the time of the year now when many of us will be traveling ourselves. How reassuring it is to know that no matter how far from home we are, Jesus is still with us. Whenever you find yourself in need of new life, turn to the Lord Jesus.

God of abundant life, your healing powers bring new life to us. Guide the efforts of medical professionals as they seek to diagnose and care for the sick. Support us as we try to be present to those around us who are ill.

Reflexión: Marcos 5, 21 - 43: Niña, te digo, levántate! La historia de la hija de Jairo es una de las muchas historias milagrosas sobre cómo Jesús sana a un niño gravemente enfermo a pedido del padre o tutor del niño. Sigue maravillosamente a causa de la curación del sirviente del centurión. En algunas de estas historias de curación, Jesús le dice al adulto que se vaya a su casa porque su fe ya ha provocado la curación. Pero en el caso de Jairo, Jesús lo deja todo y lo lleva al hogar. Jesús le dice al niño, Talitha koum (Niña, levántate). La curación pudo haberse realizado a distancia, pero el contacto hace la diferencia. Como tantas cosas en la vida, el contacto personal en sí mismo produce mucha curación. Jesús y sus discípulos continuamente en movimiento. Están en una misión, y es importante que viajen para difundir las Buenas Nuevas. También es importante, como vemos hoy, que las personas de fe tengan la oportunidad de encontrar a Jesús. Es la época del año en que muchos de nosotros viajamos nosotros mismos. Qué tranquilizador es saber que no importa cuán lejos de casa estemos, Jesús todavía está con nosotros. Siempre que te encuentres necesitado de una vida nueva, recurre al Señor Jesús.
