From Pastor's desk: Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: Mark 6, 1 – 6: *A prophet is not without honor except in his native place.*

When we gather together as a faith community to give glory to God, we expect that our experience will be similar to what it was the week before, or the week before that. Most likely this is how the faithful of Nazareth felt when they went to Synagogue. Then one day, Jesus, Son of Mary, a carpenter whom some may have known when he was just a boy, stood up to preach. Unlike the crowd in today's Gospel, may we be open to the Word of God entering in unexpected ways. The neighbors from Jesus' youth are probably willing to give him the benefit of the doubt as long as he doesn't say anything challenging. They seem to believe that the wise things he said were of divine origin "What kind of wisdom has been given to him?", yet they are unable to believe that such a great gift would be given to someone they know.

God of wisdom, you have given us the gift of faith. May we nurture it through worship and study of Scripture. Help us become true disciples of your Son Jesus Christ in our deeds and actions.

Desde el escritorio del Pastor: Reflexión: Marcos 6, 1 - 6: *Un profeta no es sin honor, excepto en su lugar natal.*

Cuando nos reunimos como una comunidad de fe para darle gloria a Dios, esperamos que nuestra experiencia sea similar a la de la semana anterior o la semana anterior. Lo más probable es que así se sintieran los fieles de Nazaret cuando fueron a la sinagoga. Entonces, un día, Jesús, el Hijo de María, un carpintero que algunos pudieron haber conocido cuando era solo un niño, se puso de pie para predicar. A diferencia de la multitud en el Evangelio de hoy, podemos estar abiertos a la Palabra de Dios que entra de maneras inesperadas. Los vecinos de la juventud de Jesús probablemente estén dispuestos a darle el beneficio de la duda, siempre y cuando no diga nada desafiante. Parecen creer que las cosas sabias que dijo eran de origen divino "¿Qué tipo de sabiduría se le ha otorgado?", Sin embargo, no pueden creer que un gran regalo se le daría a alguien que conocen.

Dios de sabiduría, tú nos has dado el don de la fe. Que podamos nutrirlo a través de la adoración y el estudio de las Escrituras. Ayúdanos a ser verdaderos discípulos de tu Hijo Jesucristo en nuestras obras y acciones.
