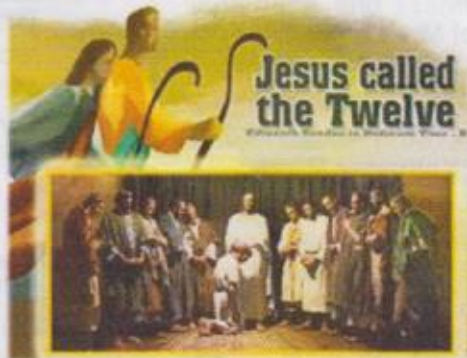

From Pastor's desk: Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018. *Reflection: Mark 6:7-13: He began to send them out.*
 In today's gospel sends out the Apostles in pairs to share in his ministry of preaching and healing. Called to preach repentance, they have no visible means of support, but God's grace was with them as they drove out many demons and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them. This is the first of two places in the New Testament where healing occurs in relation to anointing with oil. The letter of James shows the early Church continuing Jesus' instruction to heal those who are sick: Are there any among you sick? They should call for the elders, the priests of the Church and have them pray over them, anointing them with the oil in the name of the Lord. Today the Church continues this instruction in the Sacrament of anointing of the Sick. Like the prophet Amos and Apostles, we have been chosen to be the Son's coworkers in continuing God's plan of bringing healing and grace to a broken world.

Gracious God, we thank you for sending Apostles who nourish us with your living Word, Jesus Christ. Guide our efforts to share this Word in all that we do today in whatever circumstances we may find ourselves. We place our complete trust in you now and always.

Desde el escritorio del Pastor: Decimoquinto Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario

Reflexión: Marcos 6, 7 - 13: Él comenzó a enviarlos. En el evangelio de hoy envía a los Apóstoles en parejas para compartir su ministerio de predicación y sanación. Llamados a predicar el arrepentimiento, no tienen medios visibles de apoyo, pero la gracia de Dios estaba con ellos cuando expulsaron a muchos demonios y ungió con aceite a muchos enfermos y los sanaron. Este es el primero de dos lugares en el Nuevo Testamento donde se produce la curación en relación con la unción con aceite. La carta de Santiago muestra que la Iglesia primitiva continúa las instrucciones de Jesús para sanar a los enfermos: ¿Hay alguno entre ustedes que esté enfermo? Deberían llamar a los ancianos, a los sacerdotes de la Iglesia y pedirles que oren por ellos, ungiéndolos con el aceite en el nombre del Señor. Hoy la Iglesia continúa esta instrucción en el Sacramento de la unción de los enfermos. Al igual que el profeta Amós y los Apóstoles, hemos sido elegidos para ser compañeros de trabajo del Hijo al continuar el plan de Dios de llevar la sanidad y la gracia a un mundo quebrantado.

Dios misericordioso, te agradecemos por enviar apóstoles que nos nutren con tu Palabra viviente, Jesucristo. Guíe nuestros esfuerzos para compartir esta Palabra en todo lo que hacemos hoy en cualquier circunstancia en que podamos encontrarnos. Ponemos nuestra total confianza en usted ahora y siempre.
