From Pastor's desk: Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: Mark 6, 30 – 34: They were like sheep without a shepherd.

The Gospel states that Jesus pitied the people, "for they were like sheep without a shepherd." He begins to teach and shepherd them. One can visualize that Jesus noticed immediately that the people needed care. They hastened to him because they longed for someone who would provide the attention and care they needed. Jesus likely noticed, too, that they could be led astray by some and fall prey to others. The image of Jesus caring for the people who followed him even to a deserted place is a poignant one. We can think of the care that our Lord has for us. We are the sheep of his flock. The Lord continues to care for us in the Eucharist where he shepherds us, instructs us, nourishes us. "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want". Truly, the Lord provides all that we need.

God of abundant life, we thank you for shepherding us through our concerns. Guide our efforts to follow your path, pointing us back when we start to go astray. We place our complete trust in you now and always.

Reflexión: Marcos 6, 30 - 34: Ellos eran como ovejas sin pastor.

El Evangelio declara que Jesús compadeció a la gente, "porque eran como ovejas sin pastor". Él comienza a enseñarles y pastorearlos. Uno puede visualizar que Jesús notó inmediatamente que las personas necesitaban atención. Se apresuraron a él porque anhelaban a alguien que les brindara la atención y el cuidado que necesitaban. Jesús probablemente también notó que podrían ser desviados por algunos y caer presa de otros. La imagen de Jesús cuidando a las personas que lo siguieron, incluso a un lugar desierto, es conmovedora. Podemos pensar en el cuidado que nuestro Señor tiene para nosotros. Somos las ovejas de su rebaño. El Señor continúa cuidándonos en la Eucaristía donde Él nos apacienta, nos instruye, nos nutre. "El Señor es mi pastor, no hay nada que desee". Verdaderamente, el Señor provee todo lo que necesitamos.
