From Pastor's desk: Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: John 6, 1 – 15: He distributed as much as they wanted to those who were reclining.

The feeding of the multitude with five loaves and two fish is the only miracle that appears in each of the four Gospel accounts. This miracle points to salvation. John wrote that this sign was given so that we may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that those who believe may have life in abundance. It would be hard not to notice the reference to the Eucharist here. The verbs surrounding the bread, take, bless, break, and give are the same verbs used in the account of the Last Supper. Might hearers of these words in the early Church say to themselves that the sign about which John speaks in reality the Eucharist? We send you forth to reflect on the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. We pray that the gifts of God will be multiplied in your lives. God of abundant life, you feed us through Word and Sacrament. Help us to keep prayers of thanksgiving on our lips, always realizing that you answer our every need. We place our complete trust in you now and always.

Reflexión: Juan 6, 1 - 15: distribuyó todo lo que quisieron a los que estaban reclinados. La alimentación de la multitud con cinco panes y dos peces es el único milagro que aparece en cada una de las cuatro narraciones de los Evangelios. Este milagro apunta a la salvación. Juan escribió que este signo fue dado para que podamos creer que Jesús es el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios, y que los que creen pueden tener vida en abundancia. Sería difícil no notar aquí la referencia a la Eucaristía. Los verbos que rodean el pan, tomar, bendecir, romper y darlos mismos verbos utilizados en la cuenta de la Última Cena: ¿Podrían los oyentes de estas palabras en la Iglesia primitiva decirse a sí mismos que la señal sobre la cual Juan habla en realidad es la Eucaristía? Te enviamos a reflexionar sobre el milagro de la multiplicación de los panes y los peces. Oramos para que los dones de Dios se multipliquen en sus vidas

Dios de la vida abundante, nos alimentas a través de la Palabra y el Sacramento. Ayúdanos a mantener oraciones de acción de gracias en nuestros labios, siempre dándonos cuenta de que respondes a todas nuestras necesidades. Ponemos nuestra total confianza en usted ahora y siempre.
