From Pastor's desk: Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018. *Reflection: John 6, 24 – 35:*

We use the word bread to refer to more than a loaf made of flour and water. It can mean all of the elements we need for sustenance and survival in life. Jesus tells us that he is the Bread of Life. We can surely understand that everything he offers to us, his teachings, his promise of forgiveness, his way to the Father and his Body and Blood in the Eucharist are all given to us that we might know the fullness of life. What abundance, what remarkable love! He truly is our daily bread. Whether through manna in the desert, or Jesus the bread of life, God feeds his people what they need. But there is also an expectation that the people of God will live right. It's good for us to know that what sustains us comes from God. One good response is to develop habits toward food sustainability.

O God, who provided for our ancestors in the desert, and gave us your Son in the Sacrament of the Eucharist, make us ever mindful of all those who seek your compassion and your strength for their journey in life.
