From Pastor's desk: – Twenty- Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: Mark 10, 17 – 30: Sell what you have, and follow me. Today's Gospel offers us a concrete example of a man discerning his priorities in life. He comes running to Jesus with enthusiasm, eagerly asking: "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus tries to curb his enthusiasm and deepen his understanding by challenging him to consider exactly what his priorities are. The Lord focuses on those commandments that involve how we lead our lives and treat our neighbor. They all reflect a common thread: "I have never done anything to harm anyone!" But, Jesus implies something more is needed: "What have you done to help another person?" Looking into this man's heart, Jesus says in effect: "You consider that leading a good life entails not harming others. Instead, spend your resources in doing good for others." Unfortunately, the eager young man could not accept Jesus' challenge, and he walked away. In this Gospel, Jesus teaches the rich man the same lesson, noting the incompatibility of wealth and the kingdom of God. This is our challenge today. How are our temporary possessions obstacles to our mission and ultimate goal? O God of the unspeakable Name, you revealed yourself to Moses in the burning bush and revealed to him the Ten Words of a fully human civilization. Reveal them again, we pray, to those who scorn the Commandments are ignorant of them, or refuse to impart them to the next generation.

Desde el escritorio del pastor: - Vigésimo Octavo domingo del tiempo ordinario de 2018.

Reflexión: Marcos 10, 17 - 30: Vende lo que tienes y sígueme. El evangelio de hoy nos ofrece un concreto ejemplo de un hombre discerniendo sus prioridades en la vida. Él viene corriendo a Jesús con entusiasmo, preguntando ansiosamente: "¿Qué debo hacer para heredar la vida eterna?" Jesús trata de frenar su entusiasmo y profundizar su comprensión al desafiarlo a considerar exactamente cuáles son sus prioridades. El Señor se enfoca en esos mandamientos que involucran cómo conducimos nuestras vidas y tratamos a nuestro prójimo. Todos reflejan un hilo común: "¡Nunca he hecho nada para dañar a nadie!" Pero, Jesús implica que se necesita algo más: "¿Qué has hecho para ayudar a otra persona?" Mirando en el corazón de este hombre, Jesús dice en efecto: "Consideras que llevar una buena vida implica no dañar a los demás. En cambio, gasta tus recursos en hacer el bien a los demás". Desafortunadamente, el joven ansioso no pudo aceptar el desafío de Jesús, y se alejó. En este Evangelio, Jesús enseña al hombre rico la misma lección, observando la incompatibilidad de la riqueza y el reino de Dios. Este es nuestro reto hoy. ¿Cómo son nuestras posesiones temporales los obstáculos para nuestra misión y objetivo final? Oh Dios del Nombre indescriptible, te revelaste a Moisés en la zarza ardiente y le revelaste las Diez Palabras de una civilización completamente humana. Revélaselas de nuevo, te rogamos, a quienes desprecian los Mandamientos, que los ignoran o se niegan a impartirlos a la siguiente generación.
