From Pastor's Desk: SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reflection: John 2, 1 -11: Jesus transforms water into wine.

Today, you hear the story of transformation of water into wine at the wedding feast of Cana.

Today's reading helps us to consider the blessings that come when we enjoy the presence of Jesus and his Mother, Mary, in the midst of human events, such as the one we are contemplating: «There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus was also invited to the wedding with his disciples». Jesus Christ is sent by God to be present with us, and to communicate with us in divinely profound ways. God's deeds enter our hearts through Jesus Christ's humanity, and through Mary's presence, and the results are as surprising and pleasant as the experience of the host who did not know who he had invited to the wedding, but who, nevertheless, received unexpected blessings from the presence of Mary and Jesus, an invitation that might have been due to ties of kinship or friendship. This Gospel provides assurance that God will provide. Just as at this banquet, God gives us more than we will ever need.

O God you quench the thirst of all who yearn for your presence. May we always trust that our concerns affect you and will be met with your abundant goodness.

Reflexión: Juan 2, 1 -11: Jesús transforma el agua en vino.

Hoy, escuchamos la historia de la transformación del agua en vino en las bodas de Caná. La lectura de hoy nos ayuda a considerar las bendiciones que vienen cuando disfrutamos de la presencia de Jesús y su madre, María, en medio de acontecimientos humanos, como la que contemplamos hoy: «hubo una boda en Caná de Galilea y la madre de Jesús estaba allí. Jesús también fue invitado a la boda con sus discípulos». Jesucristo es enviado por Dios para estar presente con nosotros y para comunicarse con nosotros en maneras divinamente profundas. Obras de Dios entrar en nuestro corazón a través de la humanidad de Jesucristo y a través de la presencia de María, y los resultados son tan sorprendentes y agradables como la experiencia del huésped que no sabían a quien había invitado a la boda, pero que, sin embargo, recibió inesperada bendiciones de la presencia de María y Jesús, una invitación que podría haber sido debido a los lazos de parentesco o amistad. Este evangelio proporciona seguridad de que Dios proveerá. Como en este banquete, Dios nos da más de lo que necesitamos. *Oh Dios, tu sacias la sed de todos los que anhelan tu presencia. Podemos siempre confiar que nuestras preocupaciones te afectan y se cumplirán con tu abundante bondad.*
