**From Pastor's Desk: THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*Reflection: Luke 1, 1 - 4; 4, 14 -21: Today the Scripture passage is fulfilled*

Jesus described his mission in today's gospel reading: to bring glad tidings to the poor. We are called to be Christ in the world through our words and actions. During the anointing at Baptism, the new Christian is told of their status as "a member of Christ who is Priest, Prophet, and King." We have been anointed to bring the Good News of Salvation to all, but especially the poor. As we begin another week, consider the ways you may fulfill this Scripture passage. How can you bring sight to the blind, freedom to the oppressed, and release to captives? Sealed with the Spirit, we have the mission to help others see the Lord in their life. Today, as members of the Body of Christ, we are called to continue to fulfill Christ's mission, let us discover what we are called to do.

*O God your encouragement and strength guide us in our baptismal covenant. May your Spirit always guide our actions and words so that we may raise others up to know of your reign.*

Hoy, como miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, estamos llamados a continuar cumpliendo la misión de Cristo, descubramos lo que estamos llamados a hacer.
