From Pastor's Desk: SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reflection: Luke 6, 27 – 38: The measure with which you measure will be measured out to you.

Jesus teaches his disciples the Golden Rule in the passage we hear today: "Do to others as you would have them do to you." But he goes on to require more: "Love your enemies and do good to them...expecting nothing back." God is calling us to do for the people in our lives, both those who treat us kindly in return and those who do not. This is perhaps the greatest challenge for today's Christian, for the world and its leaders often do not heed this command. The directives Jesus gives today are difficult ones. Why would anyone want to do good to the person who hates? Why wouldn't we expect that what was borrowed would be returned? It may sometimes seem that it is getting harder to love. We might walk or even run away from conflict and never take the opportunity to repair relationships. Still, we say we are Christian. We are to be powerful in our love of others. Trusting in the Lord, we can fulfill our mandate to be Christian. Reconciling God, you show us your wisdom. Mold us into your likeness so that we may be imitators of your love.

Jesús enseña a sus discípulos la Regla de Oro en el pasaje que escuchamos hoy: "Haz a los demás como lo harías haz que te lo hagan a ti". Pero él continúa exigiendo más: "Ama a tus enemigos y hazles el bien ... sin esperar nada a cambio". Dios nos está pidiendo que hagamos por las personas en nuestras vidas, tanto los que nos tratan amablemente a cambio como los que no lo hacen. Este es quizás el mayor desafío para los cristianos de hoy, ya que el mundo y sus líderes a menudo no prestan atención a este mandato. Las directivas que Jesús da hoy son difíciles. ¿Por qué alguien querría hacer el bien a la persona que odia? ¿Por qué no esperaríamos que lo que se tomó prestado fuera devuelto? A veces puede parecer que es cada vez más difícil amar. Podríamos caminar o incluso huir del conflicto y nunca aprovechar la oportunidad para reparar relaciones. Aun así, decimos que somos cristianos. Debemos ser poderosos en nuestro amor por los demás. Confiando en el Señor, podemos cumplir nuestro mandato de ser cristianos.

Reconciliando a Dios, nos muestras tu sabiduría. Moldéanos a tu semejanza para que podamos ser imitadores de tu amor.
