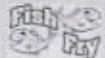

**From Pastor's Desk: EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*Reflection: Luke 6, 39 – 45: From the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks.*

It is much easier to discern another's faults and gifts than ours. Often what we find disturbing in another is a trait that we carry. Sometimes, too, jealousy and anxiety can blind us to the treasures God has gifted to those around us. The reading advises us to try to see ourselves and others appropriately. Our mouths are to emit positive words and comments to build up the Body of Christ. Jesus points out that when we overlook our own faults, not only are we ourselves left deficient, but our judgmental outlook distorts our view of others. Challenge to live as the Just One, we take steps to ensure that our speech and actions consistently show forth Christ, who seeks to bear fruit in us. This resolve is strengthened through daily reflection and attention to how we engage others and God's creation. When tempted to judge others, pause to consider your words and actions and take extra care that both consistently show forth the goodness of Christ at work in you. O God, we give thanks to you for your goodness and bounty. May we treasure the riches of your people, praise others in love, and bear burdens with grace.

**Del escritorio del Pastor: OCTAVO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

*Reflexión: Lucas 6, 39 - 45: Desde la plenitud del corazón habla la boca.*

Es mucho más fácil discernir las faltas y los dones de otra persona que los nuestros. A menudo, lo que encontramos perturbador en otro es un rasgo que llevamos. A veces, también, los celos y la ansiedad pueden cegarnos a los tesoros que Dios ha regalado a quienes nos rodean. La lectura nos aconseja tratar de vernos a nosotros mismos y a otros de manera apropiada. Nuestra boca es emitir palabras y comentarios positivos para edificar el Cuerpo de Cristo. Jesús señala que cuando pasamos por alto nuestras faltas, no solo nos dejamos deficientes, sino que nuestra perspectiva de juicio distorsiona nuestra visión de los demás. En el desafío de vivir como el Justo, tomamos medidas para asegurarnos de que nuestro discurso y nuestras acciones muestren a Cristo de manera consistente, que busca dar frutos en nosotros. Esta resolución se fortalece a través de la reflexión diaria y la atención a cómo nos comprometemos con los demás y con la creación de Dios. Cuando tengas la tentación de juzgar a los demás, haz una pausa para considerar tus palabras y acciones y cuidate mucho para que ambos demuestren constantemente la bondad de Cristo trabajando en ti. Oh Dios, te damos gracias por tu bondad y generosidad. Que atesoremos las riquezas de tu pueblo, alabemos a otros en amor y llevemos cargas con gracia.
