**From Pastor's Desk:** Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord.

**Reflection:** Luke 22, 14 – 23; 56. 23, 1 – 49: The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Today we remember Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem, when he was met by crowds of disciples who joyfully welcomed him to the holy city. As our palm branches are blessed today, we welcome Jesus into our lives asking that he make them holy by his presence. Today's Gospel reading begins as Jesus rode along. All of us go on a journey with Christ, burdened with our cross. Though our travel is joyful, it also contains frustrations, disappointments, betrayals, and challenges. In each step of the way toward Jerusalem, Jesus is close at hand, united in our passion and sacrifice. Through this Holy Week, we have the opportunity to be transformed. Will you be open to being led to something new? Listening today to Luke's account of the Passion, we hear of the supreme confidence Jesus had in his Father and his Father's will. We walk with Christ Jesus through his Passion, Death, and Resurrection. As we do so, we seek to recognize the face of Christ in all who suffer injustice and recommit ourselves to serve the suffering Christ in our brothers and sisters.

*Good God, we call upon you and exalt you, to renew the face of the earth with your Spirit. Grant that our celebration of your Son's Passion and Death draws us ever closer to obedient and humble service. May your name be glorified forever and ever.*

*Throughout Holy Week, we will continue to reflect on the events of Jesus' passion and death. As we meditate on the cross let us never lose sight of the eternal joy of "Sharing in his resurrection, when with him now" we suffer on a cross. As Christ obeyed the Father, so must we.*

**Reflexión:** Lucas 22, 14 – 23; 56. 23, 1-49: La pasión de nuestro Señor Jesucristo.

Hoy recordamos la llegada de Jesús en Jerusalén, cuando fue recibido por multitudes de discípulos que con alegría le dieron la bienvenida a la ciudad Santa. Cuando nuestros Ramos sean bendecidos hoy, invitemos a Jesús a nuestras vidas, pidiendo que las santifique con su presencia. Nuestro Evangelio de hoy comienza con Jesús cabalgando. Todos nosotros viajamos con Cristo, cargando con nuestra cruz. Aunque nuestro viaje es alegre, también contiene frustración, decepción, traiciones y retos. En cada paso del camino hacia Jerusalén, Jesús está cerca, unido en nuestra pasión y sacrificio. A través de esta semana Santa, tenemos la oportunidad de ser transformados. ¿Estarás abierto a ser conducido a algo nuevo? Al escuchar la interpretación de Lucas de la pasión, nos enteramos de la confianza suprema que Jesús tuvo en su padre y en la voluntad de su padre. Caminamos con Cristo Jesús a través de su pasión, muerte y resurrección. Al hacer esto, buscamos reconocer el rostro de Cristo en todos los que sufren injusticia y renovar nuestro compromiso de servir al Cristo sufriente en nuestros hermanos y hermanas.

*Buen Dios, te invocamos y exaltamos, a renovar la faz de la tierra con tu espíritu. Que nuestra celebración de la pasión y muerte de tu hijo nos acerque aún más al servicio obediente y humilde. Que tu nombre sea glorificado eternamente y para siempre.*

*A lo largo de la semana Santa, continuaremos reflexionando sobre los acontecimientos de la pasión y muerte de Jesús. Mientras meditamos sobre la cruz no perdamos de vista la alegría eterna de "compartir en su resurrección, cuando con él ahora" sufrimos sobre una cruz.*
