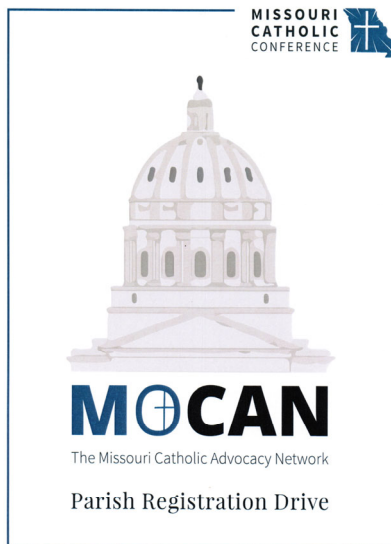
The Missouri Catholic Conference (MCC) Annual Assembly will take place on Saturday, October 5, 2019, at the Missouri State Capitol building in Jefferson City. I am writing to inform you of some of the planned activities, and encourage you to invite your parishioners to attend this important event for all Catholics in our state.

This year’s Missouri Catholic Conference Annual Assembly will address “Raising the Next Generation of Catholic Advocates”. Our keynote speaker will be David Bereit, founder of 40 Days for Life and current staff member of FOCUS, the Fellowship of Catholic University Students. He will open our Assembly and is expected to give an inspiring presentation on his experience as the founder of 40 Days for Life.

In addition to the keynote address, we have arranged for four seasoned Catholic advocates to share their experiences advocating on Catholic education, social justice, criminal justice, and pro-life. There will also be a strong line-up of workshops on topics such as immigration, gender ideology, racism, and the Pope’s recent encyclical on youth, Christus Vivit. The day will conclude with a Mass concelebrated by all the Catholic bishops of Missouri. Bus transportation is available from key locations for a nominal fee.

I ask that at least two representatives from your parish attend the Assembly in Jefferson City. In this way our archdiocese will be well-represented. In addition, this will ensure that Catholics from the archdiocese come back home energized and better informed about the issues and how they can make a difference as Catholic citizens. As Catholics we are called to be active participants in forming public policy to promote the common good. One easy way to do that is to join the Missouri Catholic Advocacy Network (MOCAN) of the Missouri Catholic Conference, the official public policy agency of the Catholic Church in Missouri.

The Missouri Catholic Conference is nonpartisan, and does not support or oppose candidates. Rather, its focus is on issues and legislation important to Catholics such as pro-life, assisting the poor, Catholic education, and religious liberty. The Conference is only effective if Catholic participate in the Missouri Catholic Advocacy Network. Participation in the network is completely free of charge, and members receive email updates on pending legislation and other public policy issues of interest to Catholics. Action alerts will link you to a pre-composed message you can send to your legislator with the click of a button. Your name will not be sold or distributed to others.

At this time Archbishop Carlson is encouraging all Catholics to join the Missouri Catholic Advocacy Network (MOCAN) to help grow the Catholic voice in the public square. You have an opportunity to join MOCAN simply by sending a text message that says “MOCAN” to the number 50457, or by filling out the MOCAN Enrollment Form which you can find in the pamphlet rack in the Gathering Space of Church. If you do not use email, MOCAN can mail bimonthly newsletters to you via United States Postal Service. Each adult Catholic can enroll. You need not limit yourselves to one enrollment per family. If you choose to register by filling out the Enrollment Form you can deposit the form in the collection basket and we will forward it along for you.

**...The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults...**This Sunday evening we begin a process of Inquiry for any among us who have an interest in becoming Catholic or in completing sacramental initiation that may have begun with Baptism as a child but may have never been pursued through to completion through Confirmation and Eucharist. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) will host its Period of Inquiry on Sunday evenings at 6:00 pm in the Church Meeting Room. If you, your spouse, or another family member of yours is not Catholic and is interested in inquiring about the Catholic faith or if you have a friend or neighbor with such an interest or if you or someone you know are have a desire to complete your Christian initiation begun in Baptism, please consult the information provided elsewhere in this bulletin and use the response form found there to let us know of your interest! We look forward to another rich and grace-filled opportunity to share our faith with those who are inquiring and to welcome new members into our Communion of Faith next Easter!

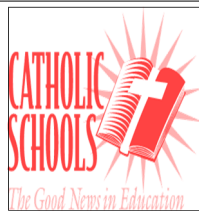

**Children's Liturgy of the Word** is a free program during the 9:30am Mass. Children are invited to come forward at Mass and follow the presenter out of the church to Room 2. They learn how to be active participants of the Mass by listening to the readings and homily, singing songs, and praying in petitions all geared towards their age group. The children return to the church during the Offertory. This program is limited to children in Kindergarten through 3rd grade. Children in Pre-K can register for the Sunday morning Pre-School program. Children are expected to behave and listen in the classroom.

**Children's Liturgy of the Word will begin** this year on September 8 but we are in need of the following helpers: 1 or 2 adults to help lead the lesson (every 4-6 weeks), 2-3 time-keepers to help the leader know when the children need to return to church (6th-8th grade students). Parent helpers are also needed to help manage the children. **We would also like to expand this program** to the 11:30am Mass and are in need of 2 adults (every 4-6 weeks) to lead the lesson and 1-2 time keepers. If you would like to participate or would like more information please call or text Kathy Bendyk at 636 345-0463. **There will be a training meeting** for all current and new teachers, time keepers and anyone interested in helping with the program on September 3 at 6pm in Room 2.

**PSR Registration** will continue through the month of August. However registrations received after Aug 18 will not be on the class lists until after the PSR Prayer Service on August 19th. Sts Joachim and Ann Parish School of Religion is open to all children of the parish who are entering kindergarten through 8th grade in the fall of 2019. Classes meet weekly on Monday evenings from 6:15-7:30pm from mid August until the beginning of May. We also offer a Special needs class and Sacramental preparation class on Monday evenings for children older than 2nd grade who are in need of their sacraments Families also have an option to choose our once a month, Family Catechesis program on Sunday mornings from 10:45-12 in which the entire family participates in prayer, activities and learning, and parents receive instruction and lessons to teach three of the four lessons a month at home. Families need to be registered in the parish to participate in any of our religious education programs. Baptismal certificates are needed for all new students.
