- Children **ages 3-14** attend our schools.
- Students attend **Mass** and receive the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**.
- Students **pray daily**, participate in **Adoration**, and recite the **Rosary**.
- **Families are partners** in their children's education.
- Students **experience faith** with other Catholic students at Diocesan wide events, i.e. Mass with Bishop.
- Within community, our students are **prepared spiritually, academically, and physically** to proclaim and live out the Good News in preparation for eternal life.
- Students are given opportunities to grow through service learning in their communities.
- Our Schools are a **mission of the Church** entrusted by Jesus Christ to **instill Catholic faith and morals** in our student.
- Students participate in their **community and beyond**, i.e. visiting the home bound.
- Students are given **leadership roles** within extra-curricular opportunities, i.e. student council.

- Teachers hold or are working toward **Catechetical Certification**.
- A number of teachers hold **Master's Degrees in Education**
- **Tuition** ranges from **\$1,600 to \$3,100** per child for grades 1-8.
- **Average cost of educating a child** in Grades 1-8 is **\$8,950**
- About **20%** of students receive some form of **scholarship or assistance**
- A number of schools offer an **Extended Day Program** and **Summer Enrichment Programs**.
- Most schools offer **Athletics**—including Volleyball, Basketball, Soccer, Softball, Baseball, Track, and Golf.
- Many of our schools use **LCD projectors**, **electronic touch surfaces**, I-pads, Netbooks, Kindles or other **electronic readers** for instruction.
- **All Catholic Schools** have **computers and internet** access.
- **Curriculum** consists of Religion, Social Studies, Math, Science, Language Arts, Music, Art, Physical Education, Health, Technology and Foreign Language.
- **Average Instructional Time** for Grades 1-8 is **1140 hours per year**.
- **Testing** is completed each Fall and Spring through the Northwest Evaluation Association's Measures of Academic Progress (NWEA-MAP) in most grades.
- **Growth Opportunities for All Learners (GOAL)** is a Special Education initiative that seeks to provide resources, instruction, and professional development for teachers in enhancing differentiated instruction techniques in our schools. This program will help make every possible effort to provide a Catholic education for children.
