Dear Family,

I am overjoyed at the experience of Allons Manger this past weekend. People have told me that it was the largest crowd that they have seen in a long time. It was great to consistently hear and feel the joy and energy that everyone felt. In talking to folks I feel there are three reasons (maybe more) that the festival was such a success this year. (Now, these three reasons do not take into account what is a given every single year: great Cajun food, generous donations, and really hard work from dedicated parishioners.)

2016 success is owed to three factors: (3) a great band that brought a crowd with them (2) fantastic, almost perfect weather (1) the Mercy of God. This last one is key. I truly believe that the Lord wanted to teach us a very beautiful lesson: that when we place Him first, especially when we do so sacrificially, He always provides in abundance. Now, I don't want us to start getting on the "prosperity gospel" train - if you follow Jesus your life will only be "blessed" (read "material blessings will follow"). That is certainly not the case. Jesus tells us we will have the Cross and many times the Cross is our blessing as it places us in a place to allow Jesus to save us. But, I do feel that in this particular case - moving Allons Manger to make room for the Feast of Divine Mercy - Jesus wanted us to see and to learn this fundamental Gospel truth: "Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things will be given you besides" (Matthew 6:33). Let us together give Him thanks!!!!!!

Pray for another good day this Sunday - SES Fair.

Dr. Caldwell's talk was amazing and we had around 40 people attend.
