Within the Church, certain months are dedicated to particular devotions that have developed over the centuries. While May was dedicated to Mary, the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. How this came about I am not entirely sure but this is the wisdom of the Church at work. This year we celebrate the feast on the Friday, June 23rd. "Understood in the light of the Scriptures, the term 'Sacred Heart of Jesus' denotes the entire mystery of Christ, the totality of his being, and his person considered in its most intimate essential: Son of God, uncreated wisdom; infinite charity, principal of the salvation and sanctification of mankind. The 'Sacred Heart' is Christ, the Word Incarnate, Saviour, intrinsically containing, in the Spirit, an infinite divine-human love for the Father and for his brothers." (Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy)

Following the Mass on June 23rd, there will be an opportunity to do an Act of Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. One can also do an enthronement of the Sacred Heart for their home. Also this month, the remembrance of the 100th Anniversary of the apparitions at Fatima continues. May 13th is when the first apparition started and continued for six months. The next apparition occurred on June 13th.
