Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, Weekend of November 8/9, 2014 – In today’s reading from Saint Paul’s letter to the Christian community at Corinth, he suggests that we are all called to be “wise master builders” in the building up of God’s temple, the local Church. Jesus Christ is the solid foundation upon whom we are to build. Saint Paul further suggests that God will judge us according to the quality to our stewardship. Can we see ourselves as “master builders” of God’s church? What gifts are we using to construct this holy place that God will call home?
