Why We Do That At Mass - Preparation of the

Gifts: The early Christians brought bread and wine to be used for the Mass and to be given to the clergy and the poor. Today, similar offerings for the parish and the poor is made with our monetary contributions. Members of the parish bring these offerings to the altar with the bread and wine to be used for the sacrifice.

The priest places the bread and wine on the table. He mixes water with the wine and washes his hands. (In Jesus' time, all Jews mixed water with wine and washed hands at meals; their actions remind us the Eucharist originated at a Jewish meal.)

Finally, the priest invites us to pray that the sacrifice may be acceptable to God. We respond "Amen" to the prayer over the offerings.
