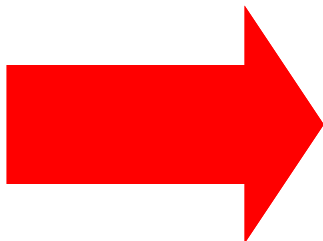

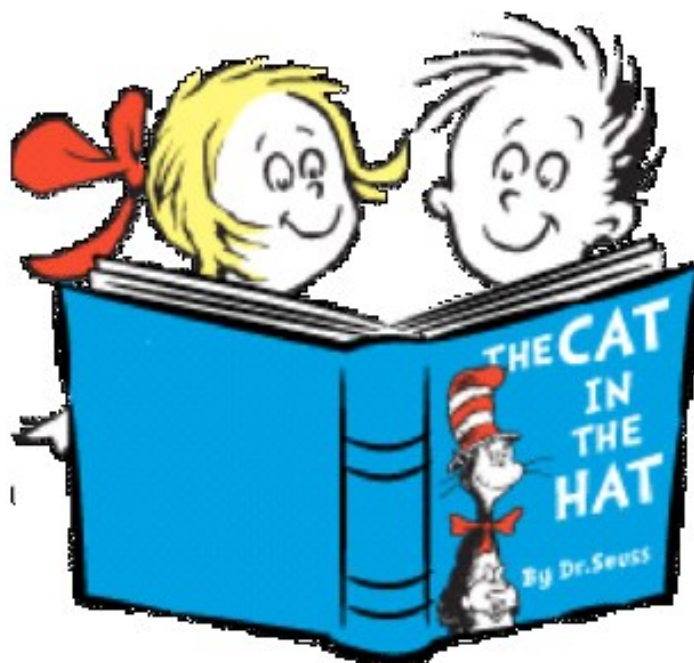
Instructions for generating a child care payment report from your FACTS account are as follows:

1. Log in to your FACTS account (online.factsmgt.com).
 - a. If you have forgotten your password click on the "Forgot Password" option.
 - b. If you don't remember the email address you used for your account, email sstaton@cdlex.org
 - c. Click on "View Details" in the block with "Payment Plan and Billing".
 - d. Select the "Payments" tab under "Activity Detail".
 - e. Click on the "View Printable Payment Summary" to the right, in blue.
 - f. Change the "Select a year or date range" option to the appropriate year or date range you need.
 - g. A report will generate detailing all payments you have made in the selected date range or year, broken out by school year.
 - h. The school address and tax ID will print on the report.
 - i. Select "Print" to print your report.

Summer Reading Book Swap

Good Shepherd Library will be hosting the second annual Fiction Book Swap for **all grade levels**

May 14th – 17th.



The book swap is book for book, which means if you bring 5 picture books and 2 chapter books, you may take 5 picture books and 2 chapter books. Students will be given a color-coded token for each book they bring to swap. Additionally, all students will receive one age-appropriate token. Tokens can then be used to "pay" for swapped books.

- **Books Donations must be in before Friday, May 3rd** to allow time for sorting.
- All extra books left after the book swap will be donated to St. Vincent de Paul.
- Books that may NOT be traded are nonfiction, those given away by fast food restaurants, textbooks, badly damaged books, and magazines. The Librarian reserves the right to not accept a book for trading.

Golden rule: Bring a book that you would want to pick yourself.
