## Announcements and Events

**Proper for Today's Mass:** The texts proper to today's Mass begin on page 91 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

**Second Sunday Brunch** is today after the 10:45 am Mass in our Social Hall. The theme is Mardi Gras; all are invited, visitors welcome!

**First Communion Preparation:** First Communion Catechism begins today, from 9:15 - 10:00 am. Classes will be held each Sunday, except Palm Sunday and Easter; registration is required.

**Ash Wednesday:** Two masses will be offered on February 14, Ash Wednesday, at 7:00 am (Low) and 7:00 pm (Sung). Please remember that this is a day of fast and abstinence (see next announcement.)

**Laws of Abstinence and Fast:** Both abstinence and fast are serious obligations. Abstinence obliges from one's fourteenth birthday, and requires abstention from meat, and from soup or gravy made from meat. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting obliges those aged 18 to 59, inclusively, and allows one full meal, and as many as two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

**Ash Wednesday Special Collection:** The Ash Wednesday Collection supports the evangelization mission of the Church in Arkansas. This includes providing priests, religious, and lay personnel to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ as they serve among the people of our diocese who lack the financial resources to support fully the priests, religious and lay personnel who serve them.

**Stations of the Cross** will be held every Friday of Lent, following the 6:30 pm Mass beginning this Friday, February 16.

**Work Day, Saturday February 17, 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.** Men of the parish encouraged to participate. Projects are to remove baptismal pool in old church area, move refrigerator from play room to the kitchen, and replace lightbulbs around the church.

**Day of Recollection:** Saturday, February 24 will be a day of recollection, a day of silent retreat for Lent. The day will begin with mass at 8 am, and will include spiritual conferences, recitation of the Rosary, and opportunities for confession, concluding by about 3:00 pm. A light breakfast will follow mass, and a simple lunch will be served at about noon. Please sign up on the list in the vestibule. A donation of \$5.00 is asked for the cost of meals; envelopes for this purpose are available near the sign-up list, and may be submitted in the box outside the Church Office.
