Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Please remember that Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence.

The Easter Duty of Holy Communion: According to the Commandments of the Church, Catholics having already made First Holy Communion are seriously obliged to make a worthy Communion at least once during the

Easter time. For the purposes of fulfilling this duty, that time is between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday (the Sunday following Pentecost), inclusively.

The Duty of Annual Confession: Separate from the Easter Duty of Communion, a Catholic having made first confession is obliged to make a sacramental confession once per year, though at no specified time.
