Handmaids of the Lord Organizational Meeting: Several ladies of the parish joined the current Handmaids of the Lord members last Sunday to get re-organized. We now have two teams to clean the church monthly plus help with the other committees such as food, flowers, and fundraising. Thanks to all who attended and volunteered their time to help on various projects.

News on Architectural Work on the Church: The local architect worked during the last week in August taking interior, vertical measurements throughout the building. These will allow accurate cross-sections of the whole building, to be used in conjunction with the floorplans already completed. An environmental safety firm visited to take samples of materials throughout the building – a necessary step before any major remodeling can be done. Fr. McCambridge has recently consulted with an architect who has done a number of designs for churches of the FSSP; they have discussed specific possibilities for the master plan for the property, and especially the church proper.

Cleaning of Church: We now have two teams formed to clean the church and social hall on the first and third Saturdays of the month. Next day to clean is October 6.
