Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Both abstinence and fast are serious obligations. Abstinence obliges from one's fourteenth birthday, and requires abstention from meat, and from soup or gravy made from meat. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting obliges those aged 18 to 59, inclusively, and allows one full meal, and as many as two smaller meals,

which together do not equal a full meal. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday of Lent, beginning this Friday, March 8. Stations will be at 7:15 pm, except on Good Friday, when they will be at 2:00 pm.

A Lenten Day of Recollection will be given on Saturday, March 23, a day of silent retreat for Lent. The day will begin with mass at 8 am, and will include spiritual conferences, recitation of the Rosary, and opportunities for confession, concluding by about 3:00 pm. A light breakfast will follow mass, and a simple lunch will be served at about noon. Please sign up on the list in the vestibule. A donation of \$5.00 is asked for the cost of meals; envelopes for this purpose are available near the sign-up list, and may be submitted in the box outside the Church Office.
