Prayer for an End to Infanticide: The U.S. Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities has published the following prayer: "Jesus, Lord of Life, transform the hearts of all elected leaders to recognize that infanticide is wrong and must not be tolerated. Open hearts and minds to recognize and defend the precious gift of human life."

Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Both abstinence and fast are serious obligations. Abstinence obliges from one's fourteenth birthday, and requires abstention from meat, and from soup or gravy made from meat. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting obliges those aged 18 to 59, inclusively, and allows one full meal, and as many as two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

Progress with Church Renovation Project: This past Wednesday's meeting of Fr. McCambridge and our architect with the Diocesan Property Services Manager went well! The Property Services Manager was pleased with the extent of planning thus far, and requested only that it be augmented slightly for a first, formal presentation to be made to the Diocesan Building Commission. We hope to make that presentation on Tuesday, April 23. Please continue to keep in your prayers the intention that God's will be done in these matters!
