Proper for Today’s Mass: The texts for the Sunday Mass may be found on page 279 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

Mass Schedule: There will be no 12:00 pm mass this Friday, as Father McCambridge will be away that day.

Second Collection Today: There will be a second collection today for the Catholic Communications Campaign. From the editor of *The Arkansas Catholic*: “Half of the collection stays in the Diocese of Little Rock to support the communications ministries, including the newspaper and websites. Your donation will make it possible for more than 700 complimentary *Arkansas Catholic* subscriptions to be given to churches, schools, prisons and to those who can’t afford it. The Easter Duty of Holy Communion: According to the Commandments of the Church, Catholics having already made First Holy Communion are seriously obliged to make a worthy Communion at least once during the Easter time. For the purposes of fulfilling this duty, that time is between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday (the Sunday following Pentecost), inclusively.

The Duty of Annual Confession: Separate from the Easter Duty of Communion, a Catholic having made first confession is obliged to make a sacramental confession once per year, though at no specified time.

List of Parishioners: The North American superior of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter asks each pastor to provide an address list of his parishioners. This list is used by the Fraternity to send newsletters and fundraising appeals, such as for inclusion in the intentions for various feast-day masses and novenas. Fr. McCambridge plans to submit this list soon. If any head-of- household has questions, please ask Father.
