Changes to Mass Schedule: With Fr. Braun's departure, and our being reduced to having only one priest, changes in the schedule for weekday masses will, regrettably, be needed. You will note that, beginning with this week, the Friday noon mass has been removed. Fr. McCambridge is grateful for your patience with this change, as well as with others which may yet be made.

Progress with Church Renovation Project: Fr. McCambridge met last week with our architect, Bob Schelle, to discuss refinements to the building plans. A precise measurement of the western property line reveals that our expansion of the church will be limited to eighteen feet toward the rear, as opposed to the twenty feet we had previously intended. In consultation with a soils engineer, the architect has designed a drainage plan which looks promising.
